- Must have successfully completed grade 10 in a Quebec High School or have at least a high school diploma & corresponding transcripts from your home country *
- English proficiency equivalent to IELTS over all score of 5.5 with no less than 5.0 in speaking
- Have a valid CAQ and Study Permit at start of program
- Health and hospitalization insurance


