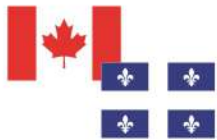

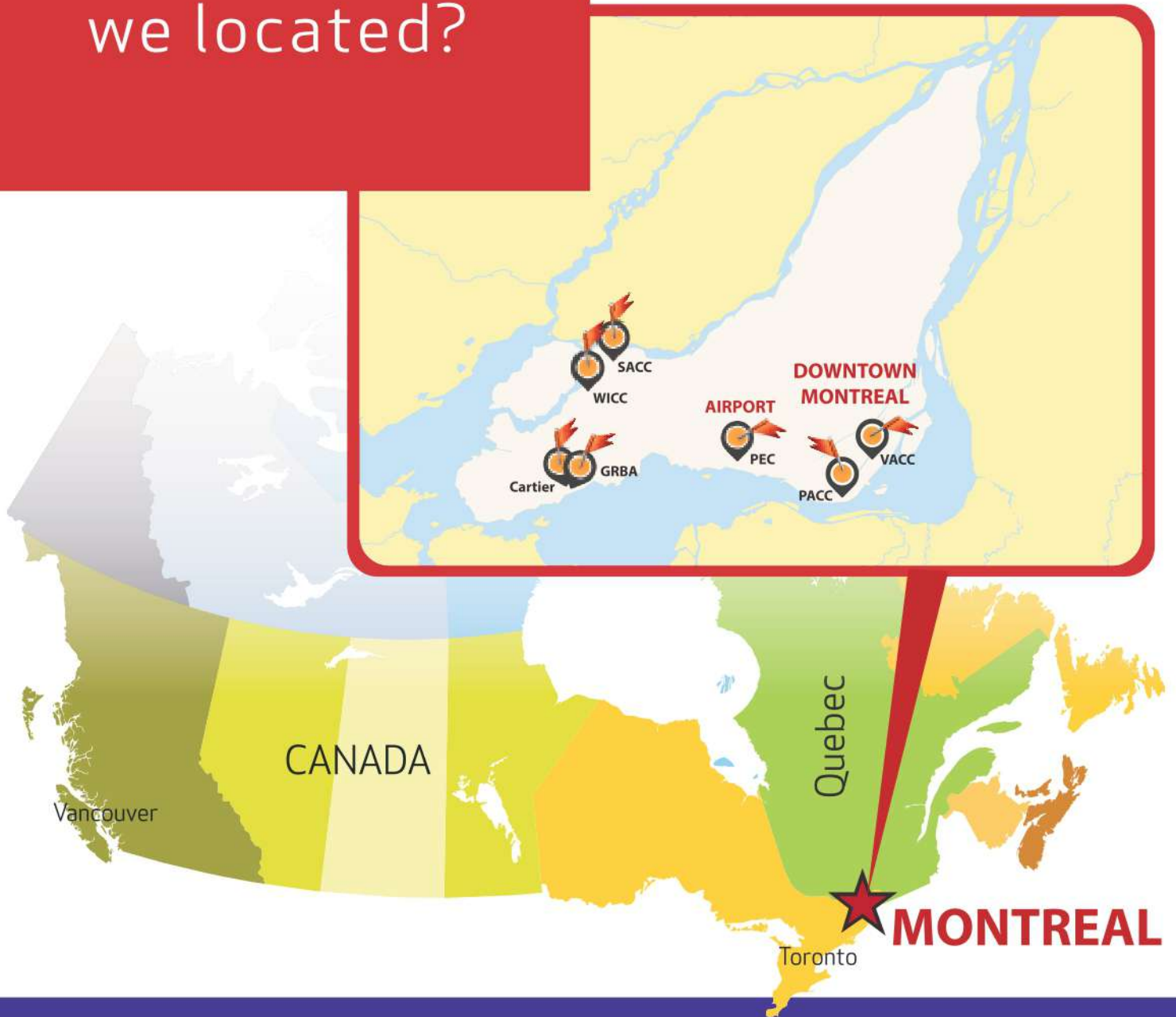

In order to enhance career development for our students, we supplement our vocational programs with transitional components such as productive work habits, work values and career decision-making skills. Our career students graduate from our programs with the necessary skill-set to excel in the workforce. We also place a high importance on preparing students for full and active participation in Quebec, Canadian and global society.

All of our vocational programs are taught by industry professionals who have been very successful in their respective careers. Students benefit from the experience, expertise and knowledge the teachers bring to the classroom.



Our programs are hands-on and include an unpaid internship in the industry. Students are also able to work off campus up to 20 hours a week and once they graduate, may be eligible for a post-graduate work permit.

English proficiency equivalent to IELTS over all score of 5.5 with no less than 5.0 in speaking

Have a valid CAQ and Study Permit at start of program

Health and hospitalization insurance

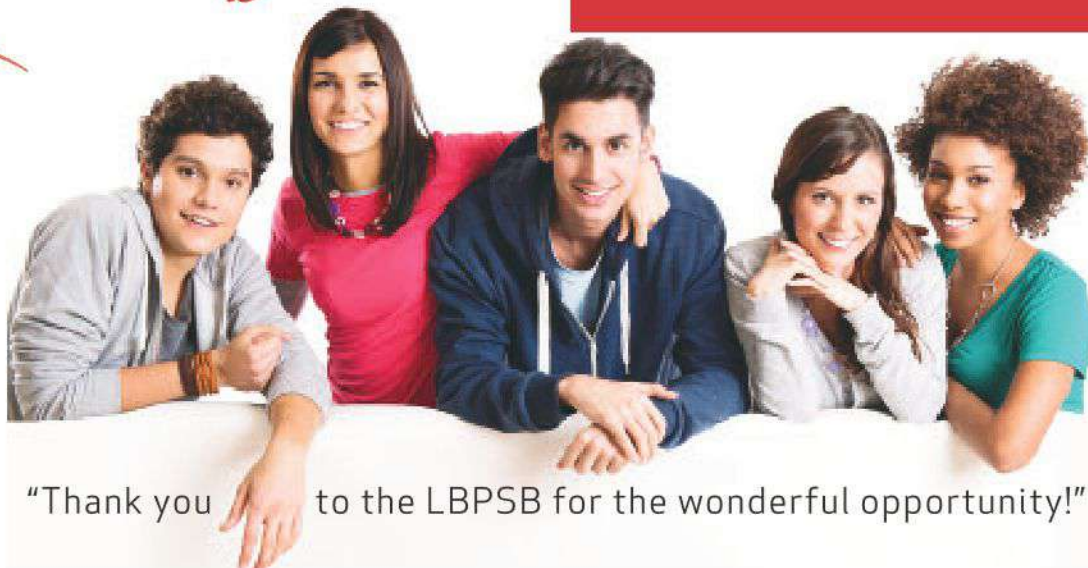
